TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Leese Fitch Cabernet Sauvignon offers bold aromas of blackberry, red plum, baking spice character and warm mocha. The nose leads to a juicy palate with layers of ripe fruit flavors of blackberry and boysenberry. The fruit flavors work well with notes of allspice and sweet oak, adding depth and richness. This well-structured wine presents bright fruit, rich texture on the palate with smooth, fine tannins and good overall acidity, leaving a lasting finish.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The majority of the Cabernet Sauvignon grapes for this wine come from the sun-drenched California region of Lodi. In addition, we have added fruit from several growers throughout California including, San Joaquin County, Clarksburg, and North Coast to enhance the overall taste profile for this wine. We find that the Lodi fruit brings bright, warm weather characteristics while the slightly cooler Clarksburg region brings the structure as well as the enticing briar patch aromas. San Joaquin County displays black currant nuance with deep, smokey notes. We have also added some interesting varietals to this blend including Teroldego and Tannat, which we find adds further depth, structure and complexity to the final wine.
