2018 Cabernet Sauvignon

TASTING NOTES

Our 2018 Gunsight Rock Cabernet Sauvignon is your classic Cabernet Sauvignon – medium-plus body with dusty tannins and prominent fruit flavors. The true nature of Paso Robles's earthy terrain brings dark cherry, plum, and dusty mocha characteristics. Blackberry and blueberry notes are present on the palate, lifted by pleasantly noticeable mushroom notes, an herbal complexity, and silky, smooth tannins. This is a rich wine with good structure and a good line of acidity leaving a flavorful, lingering finish.

APPELLATION

Paso Robles wine country is centrally located between San Francisco and Los Angeles along California's Central Coast. As one of California's fastest growing wine regions and largest geographic appellation, the territory encompasses more than 26,000 vineyard acres and more than 200 wineries. With a greater day-to-night temperature swing than most other appellations in the golden state, distinct microclimates, diverse soils and a long growing season, Paso Robles is a unique wine region blessed with optimal growing conditions for producing premium and ultra-premium wines.

This 2018 vintage of Gunsight Rock Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from the east side of the Paso Robles appellation, where the vines get a lot of sunlight and substantial heat and grow next to an abandoned river bed. This vineyard block gives its signature "Paso Dust" nuances to the final blend.
